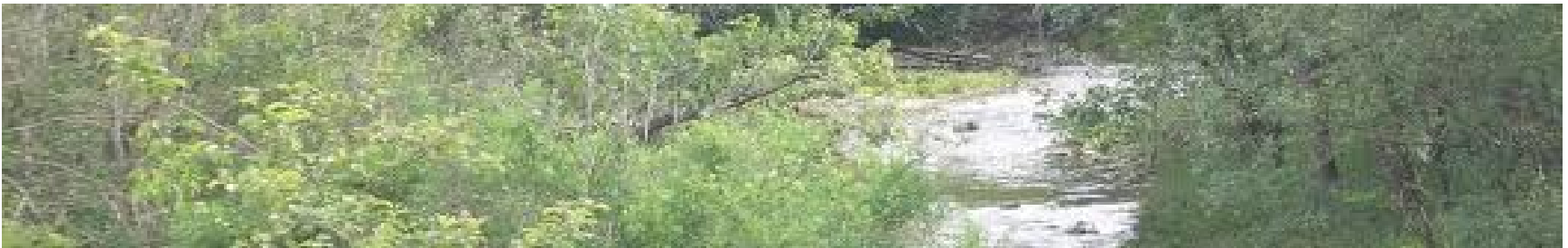

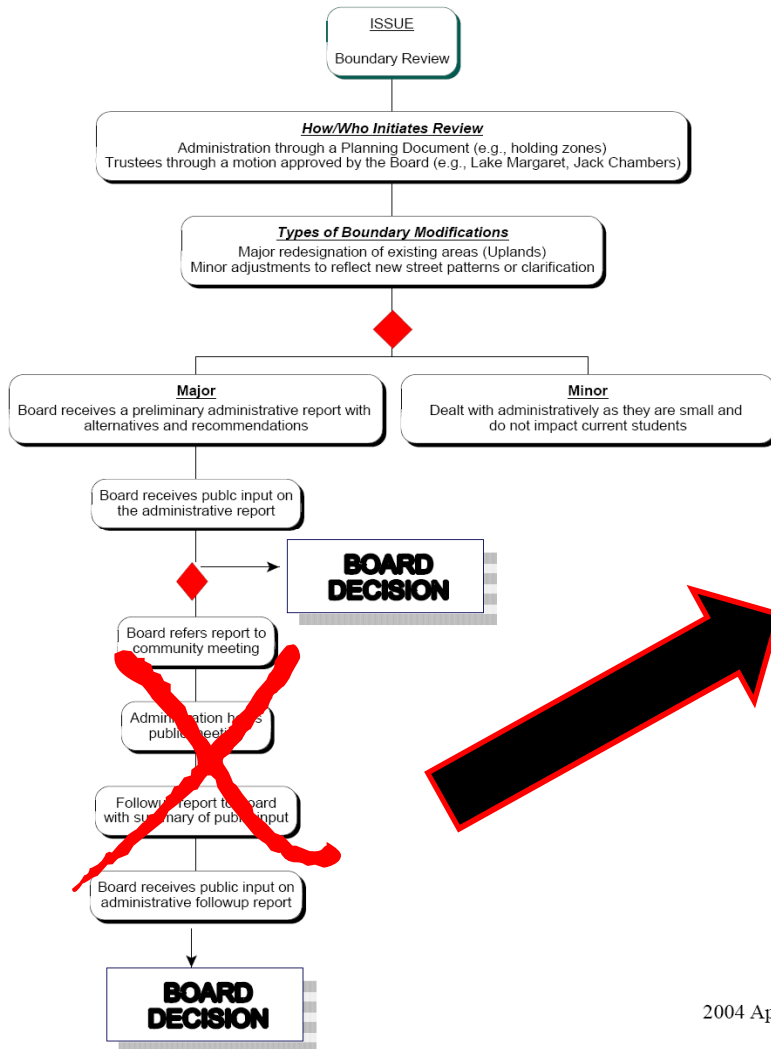

# Concerns with the Numbers

- The TVDSB uses 2011 numbers in their 2013 Estimate
- The TVDSB has the numbers all wrong!

# Big Concerns in the Future... 2018

- Any Boundary Change would result in over population at Orchard Park in the long term
- TVDSB Facilities Manager stated additions to Orchard Park would result in the elimination of the soccer pitch and baseball diamond to accommodate a larger school and parking lot <sup>++</sup>
- The TVDSB is in denial that 603 students is a possibility

# TVDSB Track Record

---

<b>Sherwood Forest School</b>	Slated for closure in 2013, TVDSB refused to consider a Boundary Review as part of the ARC completed earlier this year
<b>Eagle Heights School</b>	Recently renovated on past TVDSB population projections yet over capacity with 11 portables
<b>Clara Brenton School</b>	Declining enrollment projections and closest to Zones A, B & C but not widely considered as part of the 5 options
<b>Childhood Obesity</b>	The TVDSB commits to expanding schools and eliminating school play areas to meet targeted economics at the expense of children's health, welfare and good education
<b>Community Engagement</b>	The TVDSB has intentionally avoided community involvement in this process
<b>Bullying</b>	The Boundary Review process and options have singled out Eagle Heights, by threatening to do nothing and forcing them to break up their school community as their only viable option
