Re: Demolition of the Former Sherwood Public School

The former Sherwood Public School is scheduled to be demolished starting in May 2015. The scope of work includes the demolition of the existing school, gymnasium structure and an existing storage shed currently located on the site. Prior to the start of the demolition, eleven (11) trees will be removed from the site due their poor condition (Attachment 'A'). Upon completion of the demolition, the site will be restored with topsoil and seed which together with the retention of the remaining trees, will provide the basic elements of a "passive park". The work is expected to be completed in June 2015.

To ensure safety of residents, the construction site will be completely enclosed with temporary construction fencing that will be erected and maintained in compliance with the Occupational Health & Safety Act. Access to the construction site will be restricted to authorized personnel only.
