Scope of Work

- Removal of asphalt, concrete curb and gutter, granular road base and existing catch basins (CBs) and CB connections
- Removal of trees as required for new construction
- Construction of new CBs and CB connections, granular road base, concrete curb and gutter and asphalt pavement
- Construction of new 1.8 m wide concrete curb-face sidewalk (west side of Abbey Rise)

Schedule of Work

- All work will be completed during the 2020 construction season, approximately between May and November 2020.
- Work will be scheduled and staged to minimize inconvenience and impact to the local residents and neighbourhood.

Impacts to Existing Trees

- Approximately 6 trees must be removed for the proposed road reconstruction.
 - o All 6 tree removals are required for construction of the new sidewalk.
- Additional tree removals may be required due to construction constraints.
